PART III**SPECIAL PROVISIONS AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS****1. PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT**

The aim of this contract is to establish a cooperation with a company for providing loading – unloading, insurance and transportation services of NRDC-GR equipment for the needs of Exercise GK 15.

The Contractor will proceed to the services described in detail in paragraph 3.

2. HQ NRDC-GR AUTHORIZED COORDINATION AND INSPECTION AGENTS

For its direct official co-ordination and inspection requirements, HQ NRDC-GR designates the Contracting Officer and NRDC-GR/SPT BN representative (**OF-2 Mademtzoglou Isaak**) for coordination and tracking of the way the contractor is performing the services other NRDC-GR members.

3. SERVICE TO BE RENDERED

a. The contractor binds itself to manage the following services:

(1) Loading, transportation and unloading of containers, power generators, forklifts and light towers as follows:

(a) From Thessaloniki (Camp Pedion Areos) to Assiros (Camp Prokopidi) and vice versa.

(b) From Sindos (Camp Levandi) to Assiros (Camp Prokopidi) and vice versa.

(c) From Thessaloniki (Camp Pedion Areos) to Sindos (Camp Levanti) and vice versa.

(2) Loading, transportation and unloading of one (1) large printery-container from Thessaloniki (Camp Pedion Areos) to Assiros (Camp Prokopidi) and vice versa.

(3) Loading, transportation and unloading of 9 container of special equipment (AOCC) from Thessaloniki (Camp Pedion Areos) to Assiro (Camp Prokopidi) and vice versa.

(4) Relocation of containers, generators, A/C units within the camps and exercise area.

(5) Cargo insurance for all equipment except from the 9 AOCC containers and the printery.

(6) Possibility to provide 2 forklift vehicles (of 20tons lift capability with their operators for daily (8 hours) work. Actually need (if required) and exact dates of the need will be notified the minimum 3 days in advance.

b. Total equipment to be transferred as follows:

(1) 79 containers (20ft long, 15ton weight), containing military and commercial use equipment (weapons, ammunition & explosive ARE EXCLUDED). The number of containers can be changed +/- 50 %.

(2) 8 power generators (4,05m length, 2,00m width, 2,45m height) or smaller. The number of power generators can be changed +/- 50 %.

(3) 1 printery-container (8,00m length, 3,5m width, 3,00m height and 8 tons weight). The number of containers can be changed -100 %.

(4) 9 A.O.C.C. containers (20ft long, 8ft width, 8ft height and 5,2-7 tons weight). The number of containers can be changed -100 %.

(5) 10 Light Towers. The number can be changed +/- 50 %.

(6) 3 forklift vehicles. The number of forklift trucks can be changed +/- 50%.

(7) Internal Camp relocations of all the above equipment.

c. Minimum required trucks/vehicles, equipment and their specifications are as follows:

(1) 2 trucks with embedded crane which can transfer at once 2 containers/or power generators. The crane should be able to rotate telescopically, lift minimum 10tons at height of 5m and length/R=4m. The crane has to be certified and according to: KYA 15085/593/03-ΦΕΚ 1186/B03.

(2) 2 trucks without crane which can transfer at once 2 containers/or power generators.

(3) 1 or more trucks capable to transfer the printery-container (the truck has to be certified for the transferring of such size of load).

(4) 2 or more forklift vehicles (20tn weight, 4m max height) with operator-drivers, for daily 8-hour work .Working dates will be notified accordingly our needs. The forklift vehicles are essential for the loading-unloading of the AOCC containers.

4. NEGOTIATION WITH SUPPLIERS

The contractor binds itself to enter into contact with different suppliers in order to attain fringe benefits to this HQ.
This service will be performed at no cost to HQ NRDC-GR.

5. SANITARY AND SAFETY INSPECTION

The contractor should have the requested trucks and equipment in good condition and according to Greek legislation. Copies of the trucks' and equipment's registration/licenses have to be submitted to NRDC-GR/SPT BN representative before any movements. Driver's license document and Technical inspection documents (KTEO) and licenses of crane haldlers have also to be delivered to NRDC-GR/SPT BN representative before any movements. Moreover the contractor should accommodate any sanitary and safety inspection by quality control team of HQ NRDC-GR. It is highlighted that all trucks, equipment and personnel using the equipment have to have all the necessary by Greek/EU Laws and Regulations licenses and certifications. The contractor accepts full responsibility for the proper certification, insurance and legality of its vehicle, equipment and personnel use for the purpose of this contract.

6. FINANCIAL AGREEMENTS

a. PRICE ADJUSTMENT

The cost of 1 forklift vehicle with its operator for daily (8 hours) work is: per day.

The payment will be made within 15 working days after the receipt of the services and official data (invoices, etc) are submitted.

All the prices of offers should be **NON-VAT INCLUDED**. VAT exemption forms will be delivered to the supplier by the HQ NRDC-GR at his payment with responsibility of Purchasing and Contracting (P&C) Officer.

In case of any malfunction of the any of the trucks or equipment used by the Contractor, in order to fulfill the needs of this Contract, the repair or to replacement is a responsibility which be fully covered by the contractor. The contractor is obliged to replace any malfunctioning truck/equipment within 24 hours. Also the Contractor is obliged to replace within 24 hours any of his subcontractors/personnel who cannot perform their duties (for any reason), with other appropriately certified.

The cost of fuels and other relevant costs overload the also the Contractor.

7. LETTER OF GUARANTEE

The Contractor should deposit the amount of **Three Thousand Euros (2.000 €)** at an acknowledge Bank, as a surety bond for the services that the Contractor should provide to HQ NRDC-GR. The return of the letter of guarantee will be in no later than ten (10) days after the expiration of the contract.

8. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

If the Contractor fails to perform the services within the time specified or any extension thereof, and does not rectify such failure within a period of 5 days (or such longer period as the Contracting Officer may authorize in writing) after receipt of notice from the Contracting Officer specifying such failure, the Contracting Officer may terminate the whole or any part of the contract and decide to apply the penalty clause defined in the above paragraph 6.b.

In case of weakness of implementation of services from the award supplier the HQ NRDC-GR declares him deposed and imposes in total or disjunctive the following sanctions:

- Waiver from the award of the contract and from every right that arises from that.
- Collapse of guarantee of good implementation of the contract in favour the HQ NRDC-GR.

The aforementioned measures are not applicable in cases of force majeure, which results in non-conformation with the provisions of this contract. The evidence for force majeure endorse the contractor. As force majeure suggestively mentioned the follow cases:

- (1) General or partly strike which result in temporarily stop of the stoppage of the contractors business;
- (2) Flood;
- (3) Earthquake;
- (4) War;
- (5) Cut off of the electrical supply or malfunction of the machines that certified relevantly;
- (6) Commercial transportation blockage (International Net);
- (7) Commercial import blockage (Embargo).

9. TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE

The performance of this contract may be terminated whenever the Contracting Officer shall determine that such action is required. Contractor will be notified in writing (registered letter) at least ten (10) days prior to date of termination, at which time contract will be automatically cancelled. Contractor will immediately submit any outstanding invoices for supplies or services delivered and accepted prior to termination date for payment. Also the surety bond will be returned to the Contractor in no later than ten (10) days after the expiration of the contract.

The Contractor is responsible to prepare an official letter to HQ NRDC-GR/ G8 Branch/P&C Section clearly stated that he has no other financial demand from HQ NRDC-GR.

10. DATE COMING INTO FORCE

This contract shall come into force on the day of final approval and signature of both parties. The duration of the contract is from **20 Apr 2015 to 30 July 2015 (included)**.
